	The first router is set up normally. Run a cable from on of the ports to the second router.	
	<ul><li>The second router is slightly more complex.</li><li>1) The cable must go into one of the LAN ports, NOT the WAN/UPLINK port.</li><li>2) This router needs a STATIC IP, gateway is the address of the first router. This helps with any address conflicts.</li><li>3) DCHP should be turned off on the second router</li></ul>	

Next check that both routers have the same WiFi settings: same channel, same encryption, same SSID, etc.
